

Subject: Anth 418 field trip on Saturday 3/23 (or Sunday 3/24)
To: Anth 418 students

As we discussed in class, our next field trip of the semester is scheduled for Saturday morning (3/23), from 9 am to noon. We will be cooking outdoors over open fires (or coals) in unglazed earthenware pots. Prof. Rachel Briggs will also demonstrate the making of hominy.

Laurie and I will be there by 8:30 am to set up, and the activities will start shortly after 9:00. For those needing a ride, the RLA van will depart from Morehead Planetarium at 9:00 am sharp.

If it rains on Saturday morning, we will postpone the trip to either Saturday or Sunday afternoon, depending on the forecast. The afternoon schedule (on either day) will be 2 pm to 5 pm, with me picking up people in Morehead lot at 2 pm sharp. Be sure to check your email on Friday evening when I will make the final call on scheduling.

As in our previous trip, we will be working outside, behind UNC's Art Lab at 108 Airport Drive, off MLK Road about 1.4 miles north of downtown Chapel Hill. If you drive, there is plenty of parking in the lot directly behind the Art Lab; or you can take the bus to a stop right near the corner of MLK and Airport Drive, from where it's a short walk.
