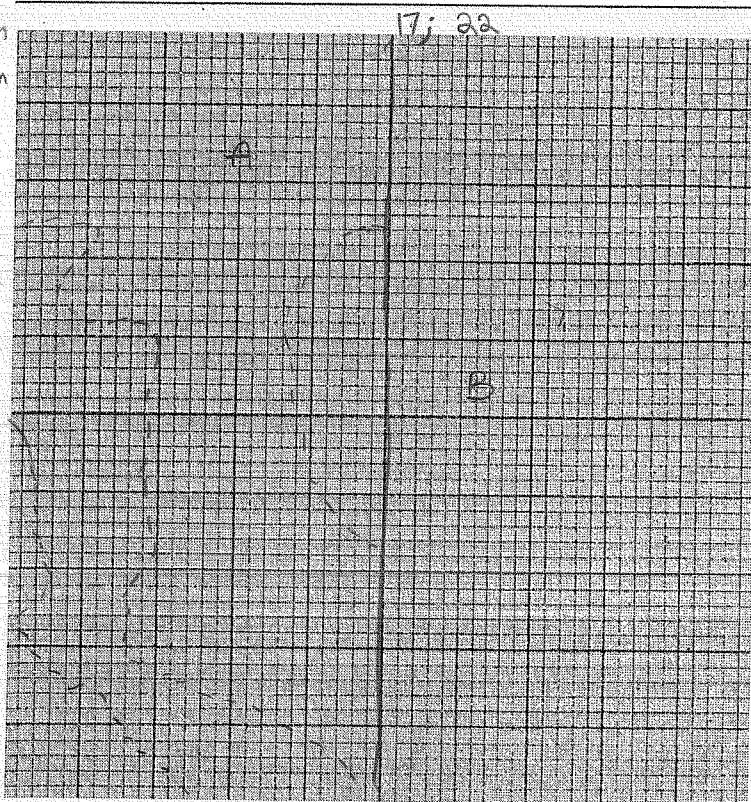

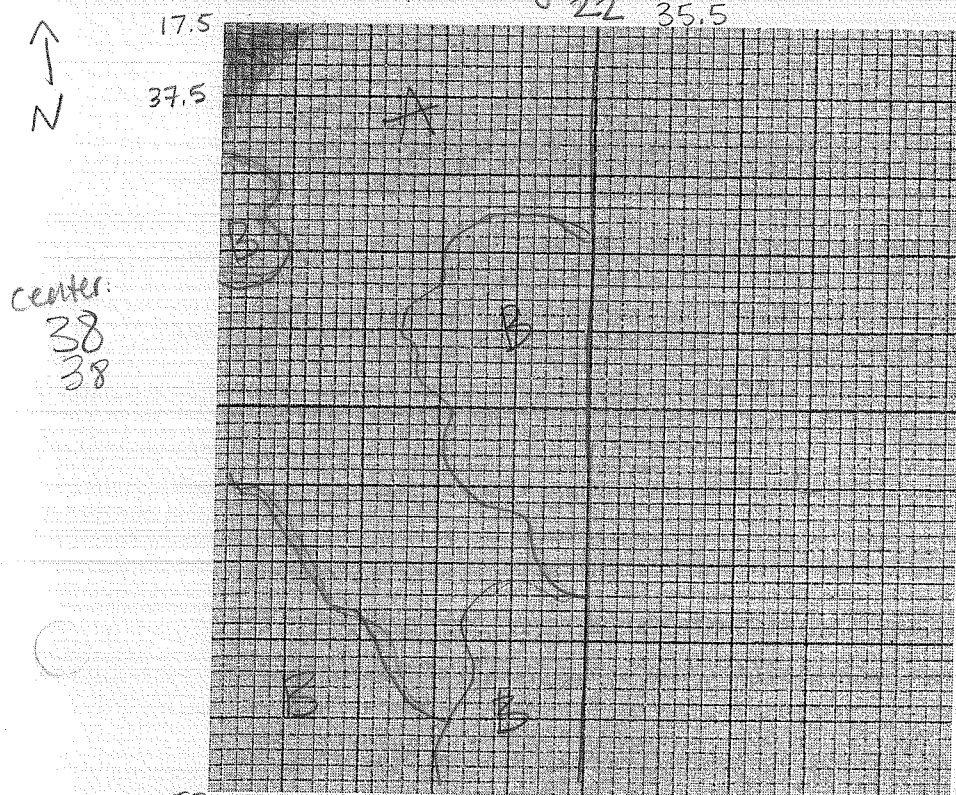

11. NOTES This layer appears to be part of the mound fill - the mottling we are seeing likely originates from basket loads used to build the mounds. Some ^{sub-rounded} pebbles (1-3cm) were recovered, as well as some small fragments of pottery. As a result of arbitrary levels, the south half of the unit was not touched.

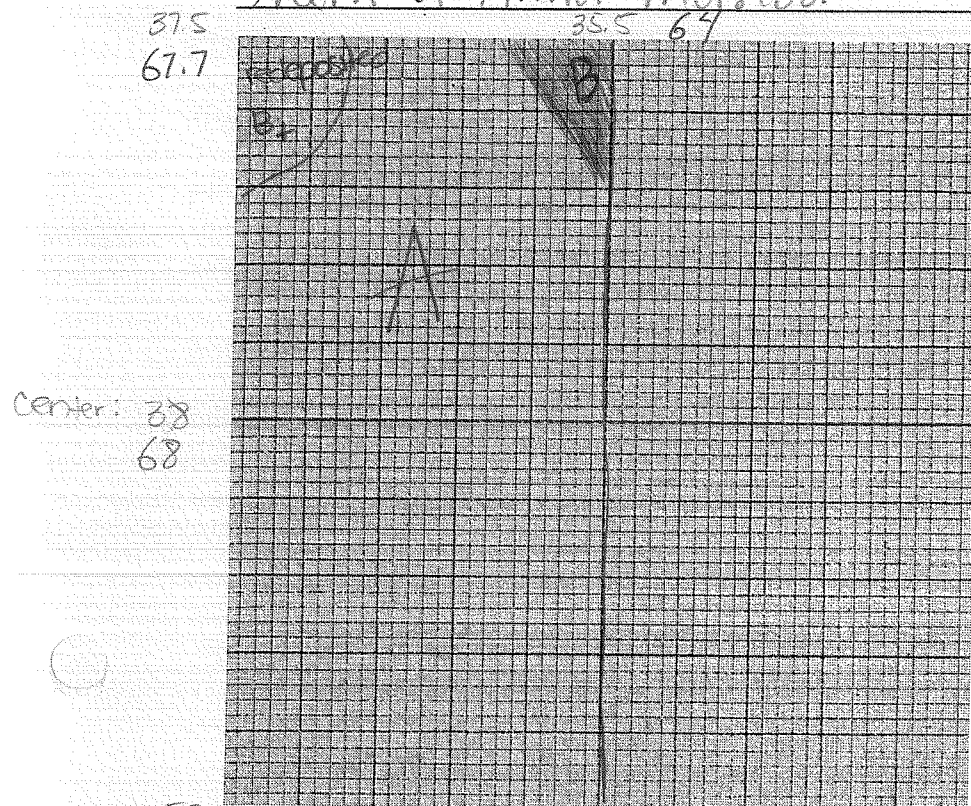

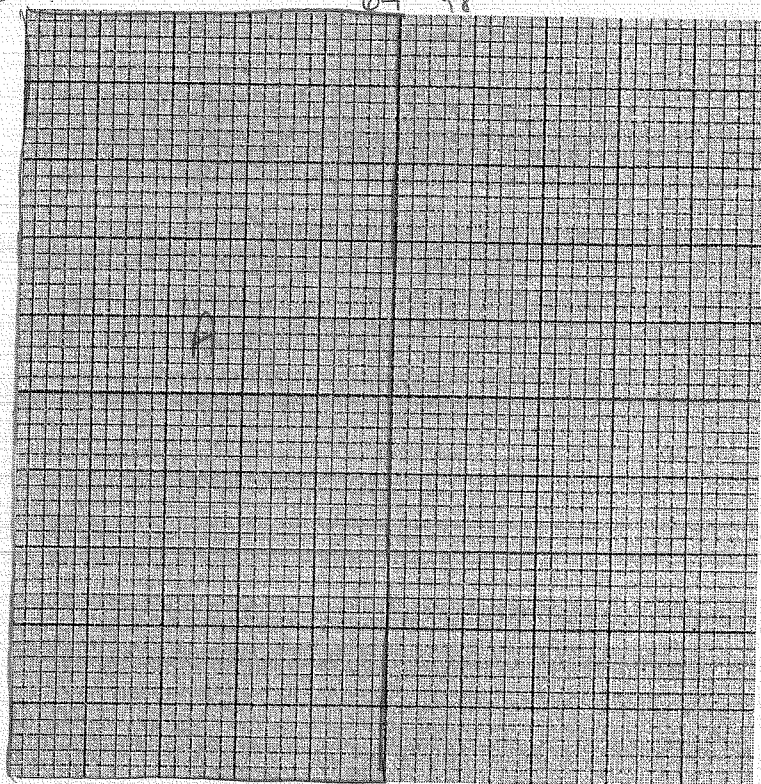
