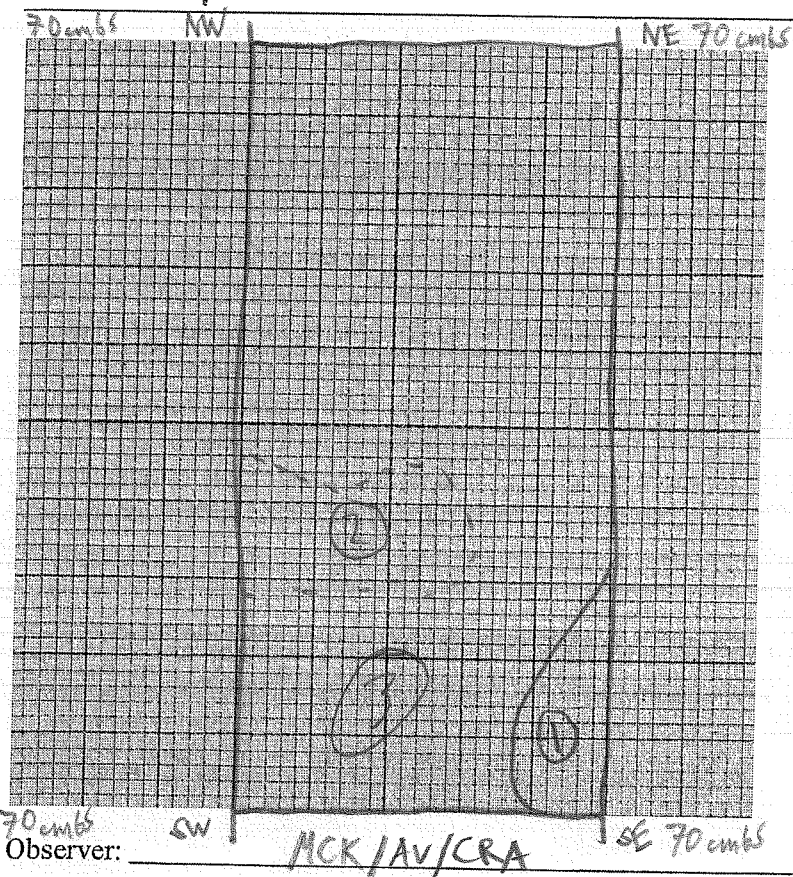

## NOTES

The level slightly deep in order to ensure that we are below the  $A_6$  in that corner of the unit. Beneath the  $A_6$  is a somewhat wet E horizon, with a  $B_1$  beneath that. We took one charcoal sample out of this level (Bag 211), while we were cutting the walls back, we pulled 2 pieces of ceramic directly out of the buried  $A$   $\Rightarrow$  these were bagged separately (Bag 212). This level concludes this unit.
