to tapper off. We shifted the A horizon with a 1/4" screen. Only a flake was recovered. Profile shows a clear mound horizon in the eastern part of the test pit. Possible signs of wash found in Profile.

Soildiscript The top mound fill color was a mottled mix of Brown (7.5 YR 4/2) and Strong Brown (7.5 YR 5/8). The buried A horizon was Black (7.5 YR 2.5/1). The E horizon was a Very dark Gray (7.5 YR 3/1).
